- 1. Request for Scheduled Pre-Bid Site visit/tour
 - a. See Addendum One.
- 2. What Learning Management System (LMS) does Rock Valley College (RVC) use?
 - a. Canvas Instructure
- 3. Are publishers allowed to place links within the Rock Valley College LMS for students to purchase materials directly from them?
 - a. No
- 4. What Student Information System (SIS) does RVC use?
 - a. The College has Ellucian Colleague as its ERP.
- 5. Can you please provide a CAD file of the bookstore floor plan?
 - a. The CAD file and a PDF layout were released with Addendum One. The AutoCAD file requires AutoCAD software and can't be downloaded directly from the RVC Website. If you need the AutoCAD file emailed to you directly, please contact Karen Kerr at k.kerr@rockvalleycollege.edu. The CAD file does not need to be included with submittals to the RFP.
- 6. Are there any sales reflected in the historical sales numbers that were a result of a one-time grant or other funding that will not occur in the future?
 - a. Not that we are aware of.

- 7. Is Rock Valley College contracted with any publishers or outside vendors for course materials or supplies other than the current bookstore vendor?
 - a. The College is not contracted with other vendors for course materials. The College procures a wide variety of *instructional* materials and supplies from a variety of sources. Some programs procure class supplies like lab kits from other sources.
- 8. Are there any Open Educational Resources (OER) initiatives at Rock Valley College where the school provides either encouragement or incentives to faculty who adopt OER for their courses? If yes, how many courses currently use OERs?
 - a. We do have an initiative on campus to encourage OER adoption and have held informational sessions for faculty to learn about OER benefits. However, there are no incentives for OER adoption and no data has been collected. We have received a grant to support OER and applied for two additional grants which provide stipends to faculty.
- 9. What is the goal of OER% for the following 4 years of the contract?
 - a. The Academic Plan has a goal of at least one OER course per department.
- 10. What are the current auxiliary revenues and/or commissions generated by the bookstore?
 - a. FY23 \$162,742. FY24 through 3/31/24 \$140,084. There is an annual guarantee to the College.
- 11. Are you interested in running your own bookstore? Or do you desire that we operate your bookstore for you?
 - a. No. That is why we have issued this Request for Proposals.
- 12. What is the current enrollment for concurrent high school students (Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit)?
 - a. These are unofficial numbers based on our rosters and are subject to change based on late withdraws and adjustments.
 - i. All programs (duplicated): 2745
 - ii. All programs (unduplicated): 1655
 - iii. Dual Credit (DC) at High School (HS) (duplicated): 1920
 - iv. DC at HS (unduplicated): 1289
 - v. On Campus programs (duplicated):825
 - vi. On Campus programs (unduplicated): 366
- 13. Do these students use the same course materials as the other students at the institution?
 - a. DC on campus yes
 - b. DC at HS if there are required materials listed on the Master Course Syllabus

- 14. Do these students receive their materials through the bookstore vendor?
 - a. DC on campus up to the student
 - b. DC at HS no, school districts provide materials
- 15. Is the institution able and interested to include Dual Credit Students as a part of the scope of content coverage through a vendor?
 - a. DC at HS at this time we have not had any requests from school districts to assist them with content coverage
- 16. What is the enrollment growth rate projection for the next 5 years?
 - a. Enrollment anticipated to be flat or slight decline due to regional population rate decline.
- 17. What % of courses have content?
 - a. Data has not been collected for this and is not tracked at this time.
- 18. What % use courseware materials, i.e. content with codes (i.e., My Pearson Lab, Cengage Now, Wiley Plus, etc)?
 - a. Data has not been collected for this and is not tracked at this time.
- 19. What % of courses with materials use OER?
 - a. Data has not been collected for this and is not tracked at this time.
- 20. What signing bonus, scholarships, sponsorships or other financial incentives have been offered and/or paid by the incumbent bookstore vendor? In what year was this paid?
 - a. Initial \$400,000 one-time signing bonus paid in 2016. \$20,000 scholarship to RVC Foundation annually since inception of contract.
- 21. What other school expenses must the campus store pay for (utilities, phone, internet trash etc.) and what are those costs?
 - a. In the past they have paid none and this can continue.
- 22. Is there any other provider of campus store services or merchandise sales that the school works with? Off campus store, athletic website, publisher content provider etc.)
 - a. RVC has a contract with BSN Sports for athletic uniforms and gear for the College's sports teams.
- 23. Are there any limitations on convenience offerings for food or beverage?
 - a. The College will be renegotiating their contract with their current beverage provider which may result in a restriction as to brand.

- 24. Are there any limitations on graduation related sales?
 - a. RVC purchases or rents graduation gowns and hats annually by following the procurement process of lowest responsible vendor to a request for quotes. There are no limitations as to what the Bookstore partner can provide to students or their families (announcements, diploma frames, etc.) ahead of graduation or during day of.
- 25. Is the institution open to self-operating a spirit store (apparel, merchandise, sundry items, etc.) with an online bookstore vendor providing all student-purchased materials shipped directly to the campus bookstore for student pickup?
 - a. It is one of many options the College is exploring
- 26. Please identify who owns the present fixtures within the Campus Bookstore? If owned by the College would these be available for use by the selected contractor?
 - a. Owned by current provider
- 27. Are there any unamortized dollars that would be due to the current contractor by the College if you should end your current partnership? If so, how much, and would the College look to the new contractor to pay this sum?
 - a. None
- 28. Does Rock Valley College currently have any direct digital delivery programs outside of the bookstore and/or in the process of implementing any? If so, please provide details.
 - a. No, we do not.
- 29. Does Rock Valley College have a proprietary "One Card" or "Campus Card" that can be used for purchases at the campus store? If so, who is the backend provider for that card?
 - a. No, we do not.
- 30. Do you currently partner with area high schools/colleges? If yes, can you please provide a breakdown of the sales for those schools?
 - a. We do not have any high school/college partners in this regard.
- 31. Do you allow students to charge a bursar account?
 - a. We currently issue vouchers for Financial Aid. For student that participate in BNC's First Day, it is charged to their accounts. Students are NOT allowed to charge back costs to their student account, nor do we want to start allowing it. FA students are only allowed to charge back to account up to the amount of financial aid available to cover the charged amount.
- 32. What is the highest priority item in the RFP?
 - a. Reduction in cost of books and materials to our students.

- 33. What are the top three challenges that Rock Valley College faces with current course materials operations that the institution hopes to resolve with a new provider?
 - a. In no particular order: Cost efficiency and cost for students, a reasonable auxiliary revenue to help support non-profitable co-curricular programs, accessibility and convenience, and access to course materials and OERs.
- 34. What additional challenges with your existing bookstore operations would you like to see addressed not mentioned in this RFP?
 - a. We believe the RFP addresses all the challenges.
- 35. Are there any plans to move or alter the current bookstore location?
 - a. If we keep a physical bookstore on campus we would not move them to a new space.
- 36. What is the target start date for operations under the new contract?
 - a. June 1, 2025.
- 37. Can you please provide the scoresheet for how the proposal will be scored.
 - a. Please see section 6.3 Evaluation Criteria, page 28, of the RFP specifications.
- 38. What are the most important factors Rock Valley College is considering when reviewing proposals?
 - a. See question 33.
- 39. Would you desire to retain the current staff in place in the store?
 - a. The current bookstore staff are part of the current vendor and not RVC employees.
- 40. Given the short timeline for receiving proposals, are you willing to accept a digital only copy?
 - a. We have extended the due date in Addendum One. Digital submittals will not be accepted.
- 41. Who is on the RFP Committee and what are their roles at the institution? Is there a further ad hoc committee involved with the evaluation?
 - a. There are seventeen (17) committee members from a wide span of departments throughout the College. The identities of the committee are not pertinent to the RFP responses. There will not be a second committee.

- 42. Does your school have any courses that utilize inclusive access or equitable access? If so, can you provide the courses that have inclusive or equitable access, enrollments for those classes, and what material is being delivered to the students, how it is being delivered, and the costs? If RVC does not have an IA or EA program, is the school interested in implementing one in the future?
 - a. Many instructors use the First Day component from Barnes and Noble that would be considered inclusive.
- 43. Would Rock Valley College be open to an equitable access program, where students are charged a per credit hour fee for all of their course materials?
 - a. Possibly. We have concerns whether this would limit textbook options instructors could choose from.
- 44. What is your current level of inclusive access or equitable access courses? Are books included in tuition or a separate billed fee?
 - a. Course by Course basis, about 20% of our courses use First Day program. Books are added on as a separate "Etext" course fee.
- 45. In an Equitable Access Model, the vendor charges a standard per student/per text cost. The institution can then consider adding (or not) additional revenue to the vendor price and consider this auxiliary revenue. Is this model suitable for consideration?
 - a. See question 50.
- 46. Does the Institution require the ability for students to "Opt Out" of Equitable Access/First Day of Class models?
 - a. With First Day Ready, students are automatically charged the course/book fee if selected by the instructor for that course section. If the student does not want the materials they have to Opt Out.
- 47. Are there any state laws preventing the institution from enacting an Equitable Access model on campus?
 - a. Not that we are aware of at this time. It might be being discussed at a federal level.
- 48. Does the institution have any Inclusive Access course material adoptions where materials are automatically delivered to the students on a course-by-course basis, and a course fee is included as part of the cost of attendance? If so, what percentage?
 - Yes, we currently utilize a First Day program that includes the specific fees for the materials to the specific section of some courses.
 Approximately 20% of our current courses use First Day.

- 49. Would the institution be interested in implementing an equitable access solution, an in-tuition solution where all course materials are automatically delivered to all students with the costs included as part of the cost of attendance?
 - a. RVC will review all proposals, but we have significant concerns about the costs to students in this solution. Any proposals with this option should be prepared to address the discrepancy of benefits to students.
- 50. Are there currently any Inclusive Access/Equitable Access programs in place at Rock Valley College?
 - a. Yes, on a course-by-course basis.
- 51. Is the Campus Bookstore integrated with the College for the use of financial aid funds?
 - a. Yes, through TrimData.
- 52. Is Financial Aid allocated to students for textbooks and course materials and used as a tender type in the current bookstore? If so, can you describe the process for how Financial Aid is distributed and then used for course materials/textbooks? Are there any restrictions?
 - a. Student FA balance information is available at the bookstore through TrimData. The student is then allowed to purchase items up to that balance amount. The book purchased amount information is transmitted back to Colleague and 'charged' to the student account. All of the book purchasing takes place prior to the financial aid being transmitted and distributed to the student.
- 53. In the last 12 months what is the total dollar value spent on textbooks and course materials with financial aid?
 - a. \$170,443.95
- 54. What percentage of Rock Valley College students receive Financial Aid?
 - a. Fall 2023 and spring 2024 averaged ~1400 students receiving FA awards (grants and/or loans). Enrollment average of ~5500 (headcount) = 25% FAFSA participation. Please note many more students complete the FAFSA application, but don't always complete all steps to receive funding.
- 55. What, if any, Financial Aid Management software is utilized by Rock Valley College?
 - a. Ellucian Colleague and TrimData is used to communicate FA information to the current bookstore

- 56. Can students use financial aid or charge their student account with the bookstore? If so, when is FA available for students to use in the bookstore?
 - a. Students with available FA can charge their book purchases to their student account up to the amount of their available FA, after all tuition and fees are covered. FA is available to use a week before classes start for the term.
- 57. Please provide the total Credit Hours enrolled for Summer 2023, Fall 2023, and Spring 2024
 - a. Summer II '23-7,922.5
 - b. Fall '23 52,600.5
 - c. Winterim '23/24-1,444
 - d. Spring '24 49,017.5
 - e. Summer I '24 4,294.0
- 58. Please provide a course schedule with course material information (including enrollment) report including required course materials listed for each class.
 - a. This is a huge request and cannot be met in the timeframe of this RFP.
- 59. Please provide a complete booklist, including ISBNs, course number, and enrollment by course, for the Fall 2023 and Spring 2024 semesters?
 - a. This is a huge request and cannot be met in the timeframe of this RFP.
- 60. Will you provide these most recent Text Adoptions booklist preferably in Google Sheet or Excel format?
 - a. We do not have this data at this time.
- 61. Please provide a course list, including enrollment and faculty name, for the Fall 2023 and Spring 2024 semesters.
 - a. This data is included as Appendix A Addendum Two. However, the College has omitted faculty names as they do not impact the responses to this RFP.
- 62. If Rock Valley College chooses to go with a virtual bookstore, what are the plans for on-campus merchandise sales?
 - a. The College is considering other avenues for the sale of RVC merchandise in case the bookstore becomes completely virtual. A decision will not be finalized until after the award of this RFP and the College knows the scope of the situation.
- 63. Are you interested in entirely removing your bookstore from campus? Would you replace it with an eCommerce link?
 - a. The College is interested in exploring the two models described in the RFP.

- 64. Under a virtual model, would Rock Valley College like all orders shipped directly to student residence, or would Rock Valley College want to offer on campus pickup?
 - a. Students should be provided an option whether to ship-to-home or ship-to-RVC. If we select a response with a physical bookstore, pick-up would occur at the bookstore. If we select a response with only a virtual model, pick-up will occur at either the on-campus coffee shop or the Welcome Center (not preferred). RVC held initial discussions with the coffee shop vendor to take on gift shop/apparel shopping options with responsibility as the pick-up/drop-off location.
