





FROM THE DIRECTOR

Pink swept the nation in a whole new way with the release of the film Legally Blonde in the early 2000's, and funny enough that pink wave similarly resurfaced with the introduction to Greta Gerwig's "Barbie" recently in 2023. We might assume that some concerning female stereotypes would be obliterated by now, like women not being funny, women not belonging in the male dominated fields, or of course, a woman with blonde hair being naturally dumb. However, if these stereotypes were indeed obsolete, I imagine there wouldn't have been so many people (especially women) affected by the message in both of these films during and after their release. Which means it's still something we should talk about. While Legally Blonde is a vivacious piece focusing more often than not on the stereotypical bullying Elle personally tramples through, our production doesn't just focus on HER experience with society's judgemental perceptions. Paulette doesn't believe in herself due to the worldly idea that she isn't conventionally "desirable", and due to the abuse of others she endures that perpetuates this idea. Vivienne is immediately perceived as a "mean girl", but her true colors show as soon as we are allowed to see the story from her perspective. Even some of the men in our show, like Emmett and Warner, are perceived from stereotypical lenses from their very first moments onstage. This musical asks us to check our initial (often judgemental) perceptions of others, and in the same breath, find our own self-confidence in who we know that we can be despite other's clouded perceptions of us and our capabilities. This show isn't just for the ladies. It's for everyone that's ever felt judged, felt self-conscious in their chosen field or identity, felt pressure to be something they were not, and to anyone that's ever been told "you will never make it." That means this show is for every single one of you sitting in these seats.

Legally Blonde is a beast, as you're about to see, and this beast was tamed magnificently by every team member hidden in the wings. This dominantly female creative team has done an astounding job uplifting each other's ideas and translating them onto the stage together. Jenny has put her entire soul into this amazing upbeat choreography, and Bethany balancing the roles of both costume designer and assistant choreographer without missing a beat is mind blowing. Cassie has taught this cast some of the most deceivingly difficult music I've ever heard and made it sound effortless. Imagen, my shadow assistant director, was always ready with insightful vision from day one. Christine and her astounding team of ASMs, Sabine, Dahlia and Jazlyn, have literally made this show stand to its' feet with unfaltering grace and strength. Our ridiculously talented visionary of a set designer, Andrea, captured our world in a way I never thought possible. Also, Annabelle on sound was a complete joy, and we wouldn't be heard without her. Then of course, we can't forget about the gentleman that gave this show life from beginning to end. Brandon and his entire team of dedicated builders all seamlessly constructed this beautiful world for us, and our lighting designer, Bryan, brought together moments onstage we thought may not be feasible. Our intimacy designer, Spencer, created a safe environment for the actors to create art in. And of course, there's Chris Brady, the man who changed my life for the better the day he trusted me to direct this show, and who offered wisdom that I wish an eternity more of. Thank you to every single one of you, all of those behind the scenes, and all of the volunteers working every night to make this show and theatre run smoothly. You are Godsends, and I am blessed to be in the same vicinity as you.

This show means a lot to a LOT of people. It gives so much hope to those who need a guiding hand in their search for self-confidence, and particularly gives women the strength to embrace the fact that they can indeed do anything they set their mind to, from dominating in a male centered field, to fighting past the assault and abuse they often have to encounter to get there. As I have found myself to be just another one of the many women who was constantly told to "smile more", or that I would not be successful in my field due to being a woman, I am beyond honored to get the opportunity to tell you through this story, dear audience, that your possibilities are endless, no matter who you are. As you view this show, I hope you feel the love and empowerment that decorates the stage in front of you. I hope you look to Elle for confirmation that you, can stand up against the odds thrown against you, against the stereotypes others put upon you, and that you leave knowing that you can be confident in yourself just the way you are. I hope you feel seen tonight under the stars.





VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Our success at Starlight Theatre depends heavily on the time our volunteers are willing to commit to the support of our program. We understand how the power of a performance goes beyond the storytelling on stage, and is made greater by the experience you have while you are here. Are you greeted like part of the family? Is the theatre clean and beautiful? Are concessions available with at reasonable prices? We rely on our volunteers, our family, to perform many of these tasks, and they do a tremendous job! Their only reward is a chance to see part of the play, an occasional cup of coffee, an infrequent pat on the back, and the intrinsic reward of being part of a family that has enriched the lives of others. If an opportunity to be a part of our family of volunteers interest you, here are some of the positions and what is involved therein.

HOUSE MANAGERS are responsible for directing the crew of ushers (during Starlight season, they recruit the crew of 12 ushers for the show). They count the ticket stubs and report the count for each performance. They oversee and participate in the post-show cleanup They report any problems to our staff. House Managers arrive an hour before the show, and are usually free to go about twenty minutes after the show ends..

USHERS are responsible for taking tickets from the patrons, distributing programs, helping patrons find their seats, and helping pick up after the performance. Ushers arrive about an hour before the show, and are free to go about twenty minutes after the show.

CONCESSIONAIRES are responsible for preparing the concession stands and food items before the show, selling the food before the show and during intermission, and cleaning the stands after intermission. Concessionaires arrive one or two hours before the show, and are free to leave about twenty minutes after intermission.

BACKSTAGE CREW are responsible for moving set pieces on and off the stage, operating spotlights, and/or flying set pieces in and out

CARPENTERS assist the set construction process during daytime hours and work closely with the Scenic Designer and Technical Director.

BOX OFFICE PERSONNEL are responsible for selling tickets during daytime hours or hours of show. Box office personnel will be trained throughout the year


